This report is presented to confirm that safeguarding measures within the church continue to be maintained in line with current requirements and good practice.

1. Insurance Review

All relevant insurance policies covering the church, the cemetery, and the Chaplain's flat have been checked and are confirmed to be correct and up to date.

2. Health and Safety Checks

Routine safety checks have been carried out.

- Fire extinguishers have been inspected and are in good working order.
- The first aid kit has been checked and is fully stocked and compliant.

3. Safeguarding Training

All Church Council officials, where required, have successfully completed the Basic Awareness/Foundation safeguarding courses.

4. Leadership Training Compliance

The Safeguarding Officer and Churchwardens have completed the required Leadership safeguarding courses and these are fully up to date.

5. PTO (Permission to Officiate)

The PTOs for both the Chaplain and the Assistant Priest are current and valid.

6. Safeguarding Dashboard

The Safeguarding Dashboard is fully up to date at the present time.

7. Church Organ Maintenance

Specialist repair work on the church organ has been completed by a qualified technician from the UK. In addition, fumigation treatment for termites was carried out earlier in the year by a professional company to ensure the preservation of the instrument.
